


Dear Family,
The Catholic Church is diverse in many ways. It is in countries throughout the world and in every continent (with the possible exception of Antarctica). Our faith is present in most every language and even in hostile countries such as Saudi Arabia and China. Also, it has incorporated many different rites.

The Eastern Orthodox Church is not in communion with the Holy Father, so it is not in communion with us. However, the Catholic Church has Eastern Rite Churches, such as the Byzantine Rite, which is in communion with the Pope and yet has a rite, or way of worship, like the Eastern Orthodox Church. Therefore, we have a rich diversity of worship.

The Eastern Rite churches also have daily prayers that are different from ours. Among these are the following morning prayers, which begins with a prayer to the Holy Spirit.

In the name of the Father + and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. (3X with the sign of the cross)
Glory to You, O Lord; glory to You!
Heavenly King, Comforter, the Spirit of Truth, who are present everywhere filling all things; Treasury of blessing and giver of life, come and dwell in us. Cleanse us of every stain and save our souls gracious Lord.

Lord have mercy (3X)
Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me a sinner. (3X)
In the name of the Father + and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

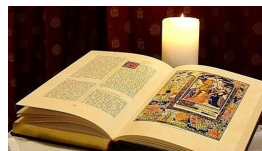

Please pray for Deborah as she will have eye surgery on February 13th.

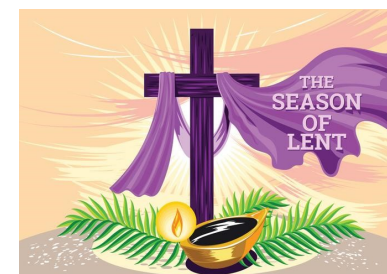
There will be **no weekday masses** during the following weeks:
