This is also a day for our Penance Service on Sunday afternoon December 11 at 3:00 p.m. at St. Charles Borromeo.



Forgiveness of sin is a good reason to rejoice. We call to mind our sins, confess them, and believing in the words of Christ, we can be convinced of our forgiveness. With the absolution, we are given new life. We are given a clean slate and the joy of knowing that we are reconciled with God.

I sincerely hope that all of you can come and experience that joy today. I especially appeal to those who have not gone to confession for many years. I do not know why you have decided that confession is not necessary, but something has happened in the Church that has led you to believe this. Erroneous teachings must be a part of it, but for whatever reason, I beg you to come.

Christ has given his Church the power to absolve sins, which is a great gift. In the Gospel of John, Jesus gave this gift to the Apostles: "he breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." (John 20:22-23).

Sins are retained for those who refuse to listen to the words of Our Lord, but for those who confess their sins there is a great joy. Come and take part in it.

May God richly bless you all.


