Dear Family,

However, he will be appearing at Masses between those two dates as a con-celebrant. So, you will most likely see him at Mass on next Saturday and Sunday. You will be able to get acquainted with him before he is officially here as pastor.


We all belong to the Body of Christ together. Msgr. Quirk has an obligation to pray for you and for your increase of faith, but you also are obligated to pray for him that he may carry out his ministry among you all. Our faith is not an individual thing; it is a Catholic Thing. It is not that we belong to the same organization, but we are all a part of the same covenant with God through Christ, Our Lord. It is not that we believe exactly the same things, speak the same way, or act exactly the same. Rather we are a new creation in Christ. Read and meditate on the following passage:

*"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, behold, the new has come... We beseech you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."*  
(2 Corinthians 5:17, 20b-21).

Through the Sacraments and ministry of this parish we can become *"the righteousness of God."* We are all in this together that others may come to know the grace of God which is ours through Christ.

### HARP CLASS

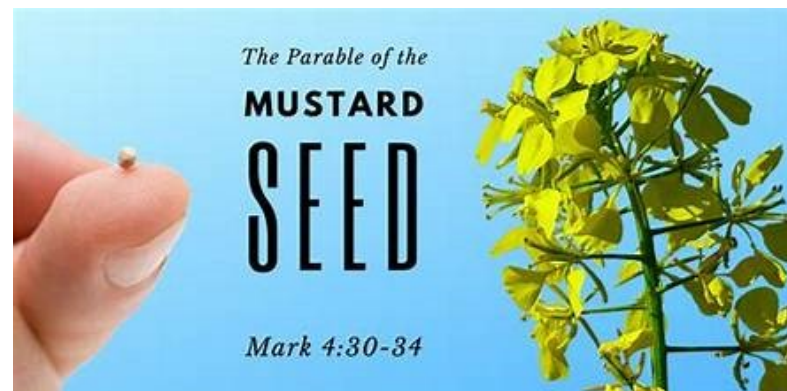
