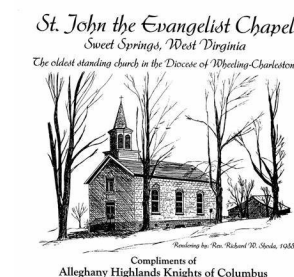

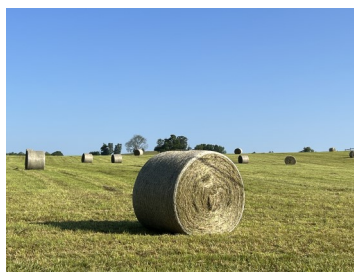

You will find in this bulletin some of the events and activities going on among the Catholics in the area. I want to draw your attention to Masses and gatherings of Catholics at some of our small chapels in the area. On the first Saturday of the month from May to October, we have a Mass at Mary Immaculate in Williamsburg, WV. Mass is at 11:00 a.m. and a Picnic lunch follows. If you are visiting, please come, we always have more than enough food to share. Mary Immaculate is a beautiful little historic country church not too far away, located on a hill surrounded by magnificent mountains of Greenbrier County. Take Route 219 north of Lewisburg for about 8 miles, turn left on Williamsburg Road and go about 5 miles, then turn right on Catholic Church road to reach Mary Immaculate Chapel. Please join us on August 5th.



Coming up on Tuesday August 15th, The Solemnity of the Assumption, we have a 6:00 p.m. Mass at St. John the Evangelist in Sweet Springs, WV. It is the oldest continuously used Catholic Church west of the Alleghany mountains. It has quite an interesting history, and we always have our historians present to tell the story of chapel. After Mass, we have an ice cream social, which has been the practice for many decades. St. John's is located near the eastern boundary of Monroe County on State Route 3 adjacent to the historic Sweet Springs resort.

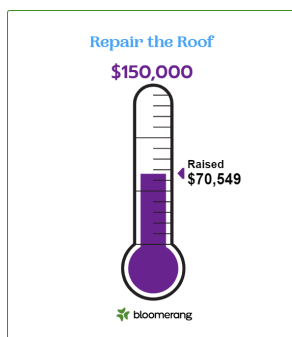
ROOF REPLACEMENT FUND UPDATE
