

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:
(a message from our pastor, Msgr. Kevin Michael Quirk)

One of the lessons that I learned very early in priesthood is that altering the Sunday Mass schedule is the surest way to upset everyone in the parish, unless you are adding more Masses to the current schedule and promising to make the homily shorter. (In truth, I am considering adding either an anticipated Mass on Saturday evening or a Mass on Sunday evening, once I have established a Pastoral Council within our Cluster and received their advice and guidance. Otherwise, the schedule seems to suit all.)

However, the weekday Mass schedule is often more malleable, something of which I would like to take advantage in these early days. First, I say Mass every day and would like to offer that daily Mass as a public Mass. Thus, I will add a Mass on Monday morning and on Saturday morning. Also, I would like to give a couple of more options for weekday Masses in order to encourage attendance. So, imposing on your tolerance of the fat Monsignor living up to his last name, I will start the following Mass schedule on **Sunday, 4 August 2024:**

You will notice that I have moved the weekday evening times one half hour earlier. I did this because I hope to offer Adult Faith Formation opportunities on one of these evenings and to have Inquiry/OCIA on the other, getting people home a half hour earlier than otherwise.

The two other emendations are moving the Tuesday Mass to the evening at St Catherine of Siena, which I make up for by supplying a morning Mass there on Thursday, and moving the Wednesday noon Mass to the evening at St Charles, hoping to offset this by additional Mass opportunities at St Charles. If there is a hue and cry over the loss of a weekday noon Mass, I will be happy to make accommodations. I will still hear confessions during Adoration when it is scheduled.

Since my freshman year of high school, daily Mass has been an important part of my life and I would like to encourage the habit as best I can.

Hoping that this schedule will help serve your spiritual and sacramental life, I remain affly ever yours in Christ, kmq.

GWEN'S MEALS

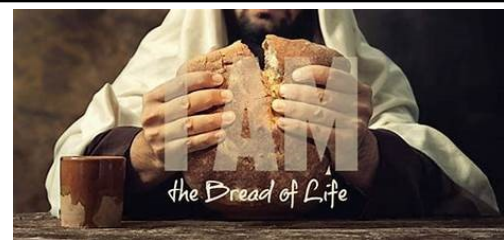
