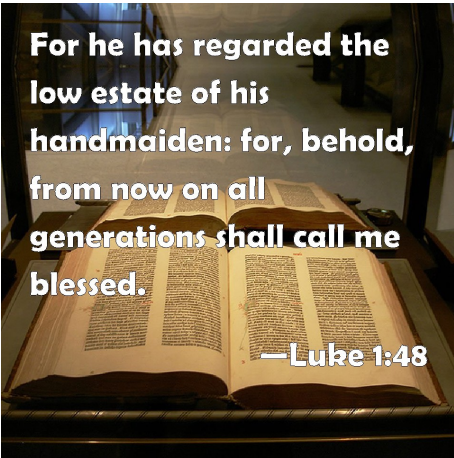

Dear Family,

Merry Christmas! The big day has arrived, and we celebrate in a variety of ways. We celebrate it as Americans, sending cards, giving gifts, and sometimes putting reindeer antlers on our cars. However, we especially celebrate this as a holy day when the God of all creation became visible through the Blessed Virgin Mary. *“No one has ever seen God; the only Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, he has made him known”* (John 1:18).



Two things we cannot say about this great event. First, this is not the beginning of the Incarnation, that began at the Annunciation, which we celebrate nine months before Christmas on March 25. Second, Mary’s role in Christmas is not incidental. She is at the very center of the holiest of all events. The invisible God was made visible because Mary gave her flesh to God that he may become one of us.

Christmas is a feast of Christ and, at the same time, a Marian feast. It is the coming of the Christ into the world, and it is a time that we honor Mary, as she said to her cousin Elizabeth, *“Behold, henceforth all generations will call me blessed”* (Luke 1:48).
