



We begin a new year together, and the calendar of the Church Year is rather simple. The Christmas Season ended this year on Monday, January 8, the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord.

Now we are in Ordinary Time. This is from the word "ordinal," or numbers that belong to an order of things, i.e., First, Second, Third, etc. These weeks of the Church year do not belong to any season, they are simply ordered weeks between one season and the next. We have come from Christmas and will soon enter the season of Lent.

This year, Easter will be relatively early, March 31st. So, Lent begins early. Ash Wednesday is February 14th. This means you can take your Honey out for dinner on Valentine's day and have bread and water

- a cheap date! But don't forget Mass on that day (Wednesday February 14) at St. Charles Borromeo at noon and St. Catherine at 6 p.m. in the evening.
