
The **Altar Rosary Society** will be hosting an **Oktoberfest** at noon on Sunday Oct. 30, 2022 at St. Catherine of Siena.

Dear Family,

Perhaps you have already heard about the conversion of the actor Shia LeBeouf to Catholicism. There is a fascinating interview of him by Bishop Robert Barron on the website [www.wordonfire.org](http://www.wordonfire.org). Shia, a 35-year-old man, grew up partly as a Jew and partly as a Protestant Christian, but with no real faith. As a young adult he thought of himself as an agnostic or atheist, and he cared very little for the Christian worship that he encountered.

At a low point in his life when he had broken all the important relations and wrecked his career, he got a call from a highly respected director who offered him the part in a movie, "Padre Pio," playing the title part as the Capuchin Monk. He gladly accepted the part, thinking he would get his career back on track, but it became more than that.



He spent several months at a Capuchin Monastery and Seminary in San Lorenzo, California. He lived with the community there and studied the life of Padre Pio. He also attended Latin Masses (the Mass of Padre Pio). He said that for the first time in Christian worship he felt as though no one was trying to sell him something. He was just a part of an event in which he was participating with others that was truly focused on a transcendent reality. At that point he decided to become Catholic.

This is a wonderful observation that we can keep in mind as we worship. Let us pray that others may also come to discover that reality.

If you have time, please come to the Ronceverte Food Pantry on **Saturday, October 22nd** between 8 a.m. and 10 a.m.




The next time you can volunteer to help prepare and assemble Gwen's meals is **Wednesday, November 23rd** at 9 a.m. at St. Catherine's Church.
