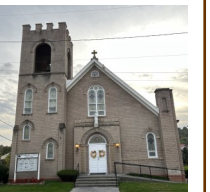

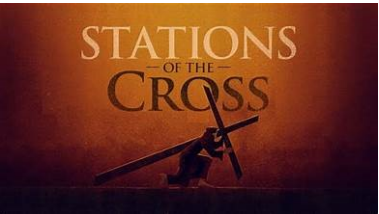

The Walking Stations of the Cross will take place in Union beginning at noon on Good Friday, March 29, 2024. The walk will begin and end at the Methodist Church in Union WV with stops at three other churches. Parishioners are encouraged to participate in this ecumenical and evangelical observance and then attend the three o’clock Good Friday liturgy and communion at St. Catherine of Siena. The guide for Stations of the Cross was written by a Nun and an Oblate Priest and directs us in prayer, Gospel readings, dramatic readings and singing. This Walking Stations of the Cross has been an event in Union WV for over twenty years and those who attend often return other years.
