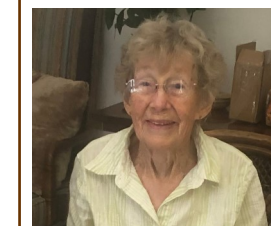

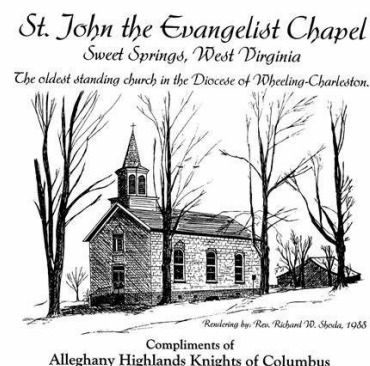

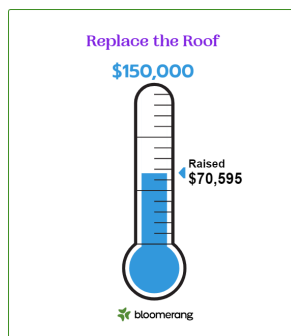
ROOF REPLACEMENT FUND UPDATE
