



Dear Family,

Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of this week are All Hallows' Eve, All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day. Though not quite like the Paschal Triduum (three days) of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil, it is nonetheless like those three days in that it has a movement of themes through this time.

All Saints' Eve begins the observance of All Saints' Day. During this time, we celebrate those hallowed souls who have died, but are very much alive and part of our ongoing lives and especially the life of the Church. They are present with us at the Mass, and they respond to us in our prayers. We will celebrate Mass on Wednesday, November 1st at St. Charles at noon and at St. Catherine's at 6:30 p.m.



After All Saints' is All Souls' Day. A day in which we offer our prayers for those faithful departed, usually family and friends, who are not recognized as Saints by the Church (although they could be!). Then we carry on that emphasis of praying for those faithful departed through the whole month of November. Note that the Memorial Book will be available for you to list those departed loved ones for whom you want prayers to be offered.

We will celebrate All Souls' Day Mass on Thursday, November 2 at St. Charles at noon and at St. Catherine's at 6:30 p.m.

This is a time when we especially recognize that in Christ, death is not the end of all things. We continue to have a connection with those we have lost in death. There is a wonderful prayer in the funeral liturgy that tells us of this very important doctrine of the Church:

“To You, O Lord, we commend the soul of your servant; in the sight of this world he/she is now dead, but in your sight may he live forever.”

God bless you all as we enter together into this very special time of the year.


ROOF REPLACEMENT UPDATE

The next Social Concern Collection at St. Catherine of Siena will be on November 19th for the **Greenbrier Valley Committee on Aging**




