“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. Do not be led away by diverse and strange teachings” (Hebrews 13:8-9a)

Dear Family,
Let us be discerning between that which is **temporal** (from Latin *tempus*, time; of or limited by time) from that which is **eternal** (that which is outside of time). Many things of our temporal world are good, and we are all glad to have them. Especially in these modern times in which technology, science, and medicine has given us so many things that have positively affected our day-to-day life. However, to focus only on temporal things without regard to the eternal is imprudent, lacking in wisdom.

An attempt to live life without any connection to the eternal is ultimately destructive. As St. Augustine wrote in his great autobiographical work *Confessions*, “*Lord, you have made us for yourself, and our hearts are restless until they rest in Thee.*” So, it is to live this life as though nothing exists beyond it ultimately leads to a restless and everchanging life without stability, direction, or purpose.

In the Church, with its life centered upon its eternal Lord becomes like its Lord. The Church lives its life in the midst of the winds of change that is characteristic of the temporal world, but its message, mission, and existence is not of this world, but rooted in the eternal.

Our times draw us into a belief that the material and temporal are all that exist. However, these are times that call for discernment and wisdom, that we may not fall into the confusion of a material and temporal life. It is above all, a time for prayer, that our lives may in some small way reflect that of our Lord, who gives us a life in this temporal world, grounded in the eternal.

The next Social Concern Collection at St. Catherine of Siena will be on October 15, 2023 for the **Shepherd’s Center of Greenbrier Valley**


ROOF REPLACEMENT FUND UPDATE

Thank you for helping keep our roof in good shape!


