THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Dear Family,
The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus was celebrated on Friday, June 7, but the entire month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Sacred Heart has a long history of development as it grew more important in the Catholic Church.

The Devotion to the Most Sacred Heart arose most prominently in the 13th century through the influence of St. Gertrude the Great, a German Benedictine nun and mystic. However, it became a universal devotion of the Church through St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. It continued to develop in statues, images and banners through the following centuries, including the well-known image of the Sacred Heart in the 19th century.

In that same century, the Popes established regular times for this devotion, and now the entire month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart, and the first Friday of every month is set aside for the devotion, and the third Friday after Pentecost. All of this indicates the great importance of this devotion.

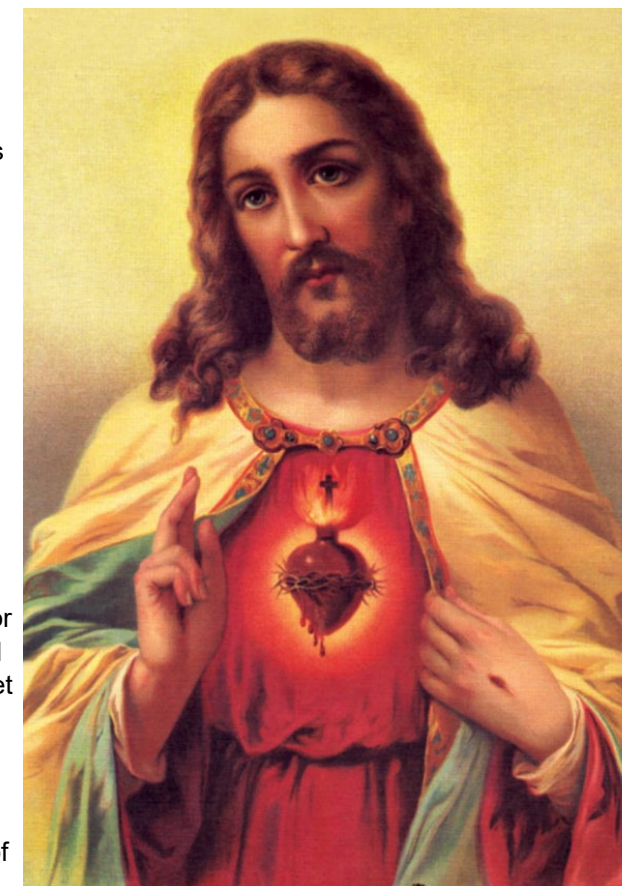

What is the devotion to the Sacred Heart? It is the recognition of the long-suffering love and compassion of the heart of Christ towards humanity. The image of the Sacred Heart depicts the fleshly heart of Jesus aflame with love for humanity.

The result of the devotion is the growth in the love we have for Christ that increases our love for every person.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is now a permanent and universal devotion throughout the world. I dearly hope that many of you can further research this devotion and make a regular part of your prayer life.

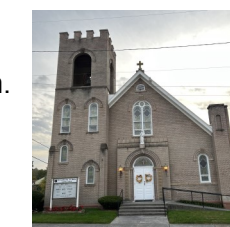
