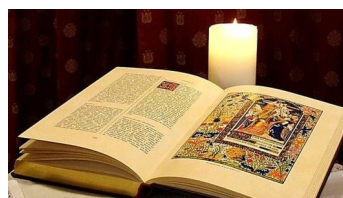

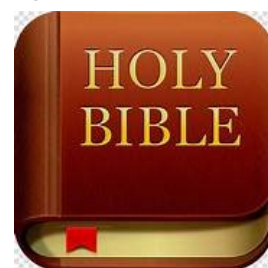

ROOF REPLACEMENT FUND UPDATE

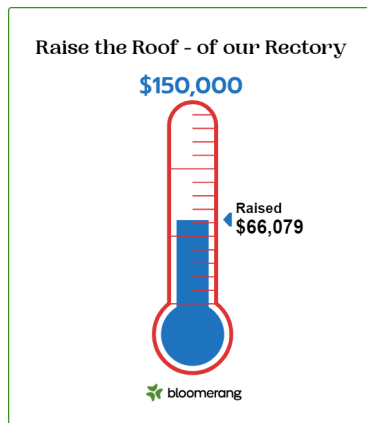
