Other than her parents she was preceded in death by her husband Larry Musselman in 2021, and siblings; Lewis, James, Bartley, Alex and Bobby.

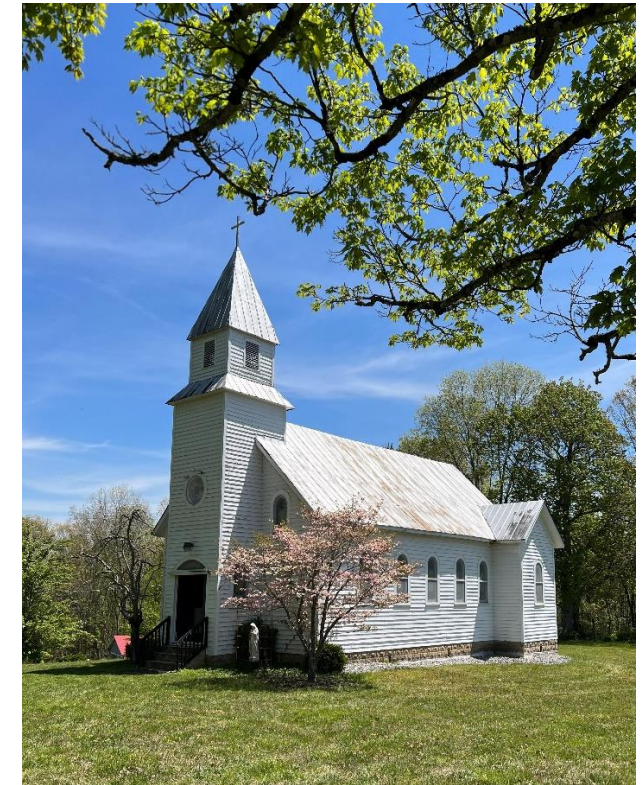
